

U.S. Navy Dog Tags



30" chain



4 1/2" chain

The issuing of military identification tags goes back to the US Civil War. During World War I, these official identification military personnel tags were nicknamed "Dog Tags". As World War II started, a second tag was added that was suspended by a shorter length of chain so that one tag could be removed "on death or capture", leaving the other in place. Plastic silencers were created around the two dog tags to ensure that the sailors and Marines wouldn't create any unnecessary noise when wearing them.

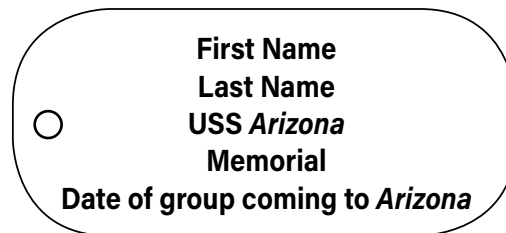
